

### Change on Dangerous Goods Handling Fee

This is to inform you that Japan Airlines International (JAL) has filed an application with Japanese Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism to revise the handling fee of the Dangerous Goods and establish the handling fee of the cargo includes Dry Ice effective from July 1, 2009, and it was approved on June 2 2009.

**1 Starting date:** July 1, 2009(AWB issued date)

**2 Fees:**

1) Dangerous Goods covered by a shipper's declaration on the AWB

	Till June 30, 2009	From July 1, 2009
Fee per package/overpack	JPY2,000	JPY2,000
Minimum fee per shipment	JPY10,000	JPY15,000
Maximum fee per shipment	JPY30,000	JPY50,000

JAL will apportion JPY 3,000 per shipment to the IATA cargo agent as well as its current amount.

For example, if fee was JPY15,000, Due agent column shall be JPY3,000 and Due carrier column shall be JPY12,000.

2) Cargo includes Dry Ice without a shipper's declaration on the AWB

	Till June 30, 2009	From July 1, 2009
Fee per shipment	-	JPY8,000

JAL will apportion JPY1,500 per shipment to the IATA cargo agent. Therefore, Due agent column shall be JPY1,500 and Due carrier column shall be JPY6,500.
