(Reminder) Use of Electronic Devices such like a temperature data logger Loaded into Cargo Compartments

Thank you for your support and patronage of JALCARGO.

Handling procedures for electronic devices loaded in cargo compartments are provided in JALCARGO-INFO-15-012(*) dated 14 July, 2015. We have recently received many inquiries where electronic devices for temperature-sensitive pharmaceutical products, etc. which require strict quality control can be used in cargo compartments.

This is to remind you that basically electronic devices must be turned off before delivery to our warehouse and to inform you of our handling procedures for electronic devices loaded in cargo compartments.

We would appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

* : "(Change) Use of Electronic Devices such as Temperature Data Loggers Loaded into Cargo Compartments"

- Details -

1. Applicable electronic devices

All electronic devices loaded into cargo compartments of aircraft.

(All devices whether it emits radio waves for wireless communication or not, such as mobile phones)

2. Applicable flights

All domestic and international flights.

3. Request to Customer

- 1) When you deliver a shipment or an ULD containing electronic device such as a temperature data logger or an impact recorder, please turn off the device before delivering to our warehouse.
- 2) To use electronic devices such as a temperature data logger or an impact recorder during air transportation, the device must meet standards prescribed as below.
 - a) Electronic Devices evaluated by RTCA DO160 Section 21 **on or before 06 May, 2015.**
 - Product Specification Sheet
 - A document stating the device meets RTCA DO160 Section 21 Category M
 - b) Electronic Devices evaluated by RTCA DO160 Section 21 or 21.5 **on or after 07 May, 2015.**
 - Product Specification Sheet
 - A document stating the device meets RTCA DO160 Section 21 or 21.5 Category H

※In both cases, it's imperative that the version of RTCA DO160 is on or after "Version D".

If you would like to use an electronic device which is not listed in the attachment "List of Confirmed Electronic Devices", please inform our sales staff or reservation staff no later than 3 days prior to the commencement of transportation and also provide us the following documents. We will check to see if the device can be used on our flights.

- ① Product Specification Sheet
- ② a) A document stating the device meets RTCA DO160 Section 21 Category M
for Electronic Devices evaluated by RTCA DO160 Section 21 on or before 06 May,2015.
b) A document stating the device meets RTCA DO160 Section 21 or 21.5 Category H
for Electronic Devices evaluated by RTCA DO160 Section 21 or 21.5 on or after 07 May,2015
※In both cases, it's imperative that the version of RTCA DO160 is on or after "Version D".

4. Others

Once the above process is completed and it has been verified that the device can be used during air transportation, there is no need to go through the same process again. For the latest list, please contact our sales staff or reservation staff.
