The Revised Fuel Surcharge System and The Applicable Fuel Surcharge
Effective From April 1, 2009

(Government approval)

Dear Valued Customers,

Please be informed that Japan Airlines International Co., Ltd (JAL) obtained approval from the Japanese Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism (MLIT) on March 16, 2009 for the revised procedure of setting its fuel surcharge levels and the applicable fuel surcharge with effective date of April 1, 2009. The international cargo fuel surcharge is JPY31/kg for Long haul routes, JPY27/kg for Asian long haul routes and JPY23/kg for Asian short haul routes for shipments departing from Japan.

JAL will continue to reduce costs and aim to enhance the quality of our service by responding to the fluctuations in fuel prices on a monthly-basis.

- The starting date of the surcharge is April 1, 2009 (AWB issued date).
- The surcharge is applicable on the chargeable weight shown on the AWB.
- The surcharge is not applicable to Minimum Charge shipment.
- Please add fuel surcharge code "MYC" and the applicable amount in the "Other Charges" field on the AWB. In addition, add the fuel surcharge amount along with other charges in "Total Other Charges Due Carrier" column on the AWB.
- The surcharge may be paid either on PP or CC basis; however, it should be consistent

with the payment for Weight Charge.

THE REVISED PROCEDURE OF SETTING ITS FUEL SURCHARGE LEVELS

Please refer to asterisk(*) for this time revision.

1) The timing of revising the fuel indicator and the applicable fuel surcharge (*)

JAL will set fuel indicator by using a one-month average fuel price of Singapore kerosene reported by the US Department of Energy(DOE) and will revise applicable fuel surcharge at twelve (12) times a year and the changes of the surcharge will be effective from the first day of each month. The fuel indicator is the average fuel price of the month before last.

For example, the applicable fuel indicator effective from April 1, 2009 will be an average fuel price of the period from February 1, 2009 to February 28, 2009.

JAL will post the updated fuel price of Singapore kerosene as advised by the DOE on our website. (www.jal.co.jp/jalcargo/fuel)

2) Surcharge by route

JAL will set the fuel surcharge categories by three (3) routes as follows:

(1)Long haul routes: Japan-America/Europe (includes Africa and Middle East)

(2)Asian long haul routes: All routes except (1) and (3)

(3)Asian short haul routes: Japan-Hong Kong, China, Philippine, Taiwan, Korea, Guam.

3) Application and suspension of surcharge

(1)Application

In case the indicator USD35.00USD/barrel or more, JAL will file an application and obtain approval for ¥10/kg for long haul routes, ¥9/kg for Asian long haul routes and ¥8/kg for Asian short haul routes with the MLIT and start surcharge after an appropriate announcement period.

(2)Suspension

In case the indicator falls less than USD35.00/barrel, JAL will file for suspension and obtain approval of the surcharge with the MLIT as quickly as possible.

4) Change of applicable surcharge

In case the indicator changes up or down (every five (5) US dollars/barrel), JAL will file the revision of the applicable fuel surcharge with the MLIT.

(1)Increase

In case the indicator changes up from the current index, JAL will file for its increase from the current fuel surcharge to the respective applicable surcharge and obtain approval with the MLIT and then start its application after an appropriate announcement period.

(2)Decrease

In case the indicator changes down from the current index, JAL will file for its decrease from the current fuel surcharge to the respective applicable surcharge and obtain approval with the MLIT and then start its application as soon as possible.
